The short answer

Amazon's notice is a classification signal. Product facts and claims determine the route.

Do not edit or appeal until you identify the product, mechanism, treatment, claim universe and production chain. The evidence must support one route - not ten contradictory theories.

WHAT THIS CHANGES IN PRACTICE

REGULATED PRODUCT / DEVICE - follow the correct federal, label, production and Amazon route.

ORDINARY PRODUCT + CLAIM - support and classify the claim, or correct a genuinely erroneous claim everywhere.

GENUINE FALSE FLAG - prove no substance or treatment, no device function and no pesticidal claim.

BOUNDARY: Claim-triggered is a diagnostic description, not a third FIFRA exemption. [S01-S08]



Preserve the record before you edit

Save what Amazon saw - or may have seen - before evidence disappears.

01	ENFORCEMENT RECORD	Full notice; ASIN, SKU, marketplace, variation and FNSKU; requested field or document; timestamped screenshots; case and feed IDs; FBA quantity and every removal or disposal deadline.
02	PHYSICAL PRODUCT	Bill of materials, ingredients, coatings and treatments; energy and mechanism; bundled cartridge, substance or precursor; factory, final packaging, relabeling and import chain.
03	CLAIM UNIVERSE	Amazon front end and contributed data; A+ and brand content; product, package, insert and instructions; brand, manufacturer and distributor pages; catalog history.
04	CLAIM EVIDENCE	Exact wording or image, location and source; mechanism or treatment; test method, configuration, conditions and limitations; registration or exemption compatibility; consumer takeaway.

DO NOT EDIT FIRST. Preserve the before state, then make the narrowest accurate correction supported by product-specific facts.

SOURCE BOUNDARY: Amazon publicly identifies detail-page text and images; hidden classifier inputs are not disclosed. [S01,S14]



Start with the object, not 'chemical-free'

Ask what produces the pest-control effect. The housing alone does not decide the category.

PRODUCT CONFIGURATION	WHAT TO ESTABLISH	FIRST ISSUE TO INVESTIGATE
SUBSTANCE / TREATMENT	Liquid, powder, coating, treated surface or other pesticidal substance	Potential pesticide or treated article; identify substance, intended use and registration or exemption status
PHYSICAL INSTRUMENT	Traps, destroys, repels or mitigates through physical or mechanical action	Potential pesticide device even when no active chemical is present
GENERATOR	Hardware produces a pesticidal substance; determine inputs, output and sales configuration	Fact dependent; hardware is not automatically a device
HARDWARE + INPUT	Salt, precursor, cartridge or pesticide is sold or distributed with the machine	Combined offering may be a pesticide product rather than a standalone device
STANDALONE APPLICATOR	Equipment merely applies a separate pesticide	May be application equipment rather than a pesticide device
BARRIER / DETECTION	No-toxicant physical barrier or survey/detection attractant; no pesticidal claim	Possible 40 CFR 152.10 route only if every condition fits; a trap is not a barrier

CLASSIFICATION BOUNDARY: No chemical is not a false-flag argument; a physical trap or repeller may be a real device. [S02-S06]

Document what actually produces the effect

A supplier statement that the item is chemical-free is not a classification memo.

01 COMPOSITION / TREATMENT

Ingredients, coatings, impregnation, antimicrobial or repellent additives, attractants and replaceable cartridges.

02 MECHANISM / FUNCTION

Does the unit trap, filter, irradiate, shock, emit, generate, dispense, repel or otherwise mitigate a pest?

03 BUNDLED INPUT / OUTPUT

Identify every salt, precursor, pesticide or cartridge supplied with it and any pesticidal substance the unit generates.

04 INTENDED USE / CLAIM

Name the target, use site, express wording, implied images and the product facts that make the claim true or false.

05 PRODUCTION CHAIN

Factory, final packaging, relabeling, container changes, importer and the establishment that finally produced the unit.

STOP QUESTIONS: What causes the effect? Does the design still control pests if one sentence is deleted? Who finally manufactured, packaged or relabeled the unit?

OUTPUT: A product-fact sheet that can support classification, not a marketing description. [S02-S06,S11-S12]



Audit the claim universe in a fixed order

A clean title does not establish that the product, package or catalog is clean.

01	AMAZON FRONT END	Title, bullets, description, images, video, variation labels and comparison charts.
02	CONTRIBUTED DATA	Backend search terms, subject matter, category attributes, Pesticide Marking, reports and feed history.
03	BRAND CONTENT	Every A+ module, Brand Story, Storefront and localized or auto-created version you control.
04	PHYSICAL PRODUCT	All sides of the item and box; label, hangtag, insert, instructions, warranty and QR-linked material.
05	OFF-AMAZON CONTEXT	Brand, manufacturer and distributor copy; ads, brochures, adopted testimonials and efficacy-study links.
06	CATALOG HISTORY	Old claims and images, shared ASIN contributions, variation-level data and prior uploads.

BOUNDARY: Shared, losing, historical or translated contributions are reasonable troubleshooting questions - not disclosed universal classifier inputs. Off-Amazon material still matters to federal intended-use analysis.

AUDIT ORDER: preserve first, inspect every surface, then match each claim to product-specific evidence. [S01,S04,S07]



Read the whole claim in context

There is no reliable public Amazon pesticide trigger-word list. The object, mechanism and full presentation control.

CLAIM OR CONTEXT	SIGNAL	REQUIRED NEXT CHECK
Disinfects, sanitizes or sterilizes a surface	PESTICIDAL	Classify the substance or mechanism and the label route
Controls odor-causing bacteria	PESTICIDAL	Targets bacteria, not merely the odor
Deodorizes or removes odors only	GENERALLY NONPESTICIDAL	Confirm no pest-control implication in context
Kills, prevents or resists mold or mildew	PESTICIDAL	Check pesticide, device or treated-article status
Removes stains caused by mold or mildew only	GENERALLY NONPESTICIDAL	Keep the complete context limited to stain removal
Removes allergens, unqualified	CAN BE PESTICIDAL	Identify living pest versus nonliving matter
Removes nonliving dander or pest matter	GENERALLY NONPESTICIDAL	State nonliving removal; do not imply pest control
HEPA particle trapping at stated sizes	NOT A DEVICE CLAIM BY ITSELF	Confirm there is no kill, destroy or mitigate claim
Kills airborne bacteria or destroys viruses	STRONG CLASSIFICATION ISSUE	Mechanism controls device versus pesticide analysis
Antimicrobial protection for an article	TREATED-ARTICLE ANALYSIS	Verify registered treatment/use and article-only protection
Germ shield, crossed-out pest or before/after image	IMPLIED CLAIM POSSIBLE	Review the whole presentation, not only verbs

CONTEXT LIMIT: Microorganisms on or in living humans or animals are not collapsed into the surface, air, water or article analysis. [S04,S05,S07]

Do not collapse number, exemption and approval

Each label answers a different question. Use the exact status and the evidence that belongs to it.

EPA REGISTRATION NUMBER	Specific federally registered pesticide product	Product label and registration status	Not the ordinary identifier for a device; not federal endorsement
EPA ESTABLISHMENT NUMBER	Final establishment where a pesticide or regulated device was produced	Label or immediate container; outer package when required for visibility	Not product registration, safety or efficacy review, approval, or proof of current compliance
EPA COMPANY NUMBER	Company in EPA's administrative system	Component of registration or establishment identifiers and applications	Not an approved product or registered producing location by itself
TREATED ARTICLE EXEMPTION	Registered pesticide used for that specific use and intended to protect the article itself	Treatment, accepted use and article-only protection claim	Not automatic for an antimicrobial article or public-health claim
MINIMUM-RISK 25(b)	A pesticide exempt from FIFRA registration only while every condition is met	Ingredients, percentages, label, contact and claim restrictions; state review	Not a device, EPA registration, certification or approval
'EPA APPROVED'	Imprecise marketing characterization	Replace with the exact product, establishment or exemption status	Never infer approval or endorsement from a Registration or Establishment Number

FAST CHECK

Reg. No. often resembles 12345-67. Est. No. includes a state or country code and facility identifier, such as 12345-PA-01. A company number alone is neither one. A regulated device ordinarily bears an Est. No., not a Reg. No.; a registered pesticide ordinarily has both.

STATUS BOUNDARY: Limited EPA device nonregulation policies are separate and must not be generalized. [S02,S06,S08-S11]



Choose the route only after the audit

The output is the next action supported by evidence - not a guarantee of Amazon reinstatement.

INPUT: AMAZON PESTICIDE / DEVICE FLAG - A MARKETPLACE SIGNAL, NOT AN EPA LEGAL FINDING

ROUTE 01

REGULATED PRODUCT / DEVICE

Pest-control substance, treatment or physical function is supported. Establish the correct product, device or exemption status and complete the matching compliance and Amazon route.

ROUTE 02

CLAIM CORRECTION / RECLASSIFICATION

The object appears ordinary but a claim exists. If the claim is true, move to Route 01 or a valid exemption analysis. If genuinely erroneous, correct it everywhere and preserve the change record.

ROUTE 03

GENUINE FALSE FLAG APPEAL

Use only when all three negatives are proven. Submit a documented negative case and ask Amazon to identify any exact claim, image, attribute or contribution it still relies on.

DECISION RULE: Do not select 'not a pesticide' merely because a true trap, UV unit or repeller has no active chemical. [S01-S10]

One route, one evidence packet, one remedy

Keep known facts, missing proof and the next action coherent for the same ASIN and product.

01 REGULATED PRODUCT / DEVICE	A pesticidal substance, treatment, generator output or physical pest-control function is supported	Exact identity and mechanism; registration, exemption or device status; label and final producer; claims; state, import and Amazon requirements	Complete the matching route and field value. STOP: do not certify 'not a pesticide.'
02 ORDINARY PRODUCT + CLAIM	The product appears ordinary, but an express or implied pesticidal claim exists	Exact wording, image and source; truth or error; treatment/design; all current sales surfaces; before-and-after record	Truthful claim: classify or test exemption. Erroneous claim: correct everywhere. STOP: do not hide intended use.
03 GENUINE FALSE FLAG	No regulated substance/treatment, no physical device function and no pesticidal claim are supported	Materials and supplier declaration; complete photos; instructions; catalog audit/report; Pesticide Marking and change record	Submit a negative-case appeal and request the exact disputed content. STOP: unresolved hidden data is not proof of absence.

EVIDENCE PACKET RULE

Product identity, mechanism, composition or treatment, intended use, catalog facts and the requested remedy must describe the same route. A package that says 'not a pesticide' while the box says 'kills 99.9% of bacteria' defeats itself.

OUTPUT: next action and retained record - not a legal opinion or marketplace guarantee. [S01-S14]

Replace shortcut claims with the missing proof

A failed argument usually answers a different question from the one classification requires.

WEAK CLAIM	EVIDENCE-LED RECOVERY
'It has no chemicals'	Document the physical mechanism and intended pest-control function; a device can be chemical-free
'It has no EPA number'	Identify the actual category, then distinguish Registration Number, Establishment Number and exemption
'Competitors sell it' / 'sold for years'	Use product-specific facts and current status; marketplace history is not legal classification
'The listing looks clean'	Audit backend data, A+, product, packaging, instructions, other marketing and catalog history
'We deleted the words'	Show that the correction is factually accurate and complete; do not hide a real treatment, design or intended use
'Training, a U.S. LLC or an Est. No. solves it'	Keep seller eligibility, product classification, establishment status and Amazon review separate
'The feed processed successfully'	Verify the submitted value won the catalog contribution and that the policy restriction actually cleared
'We deleted the offer / made another ASIN'	Deletion is not an appeal and a duplicate ASIN can be evasion; preserve evidence and resolve the notice

LOCKED-EDIT LOOP

01 POLICY - use the appeal control shown in the notice or Account Health.
02 CATALOG - use Seller Support or Brand Registry Support for a locked, missing or losing value.
03 LINK - cross-reference case IDs and attach the same before-and-after evidence.
04 VERIFY - check the catalog value, policy status, offer and stranded-inventory deadline separately.

NEVER: invent a number, borrow another product's registration, alter a report, evade with a duplicate ASIN, or promise review time. [S01-S14]

Use the current Pesticide Marking instruction

Amazon uses one compliance attribute for four materially different assertions. Confirm the live help page and newest template before submission.

PRODUCT STATUS	DROPDOWN	REGISTRATION STATUS	CERTIFICATION NUMBER
Federally registered pesticide	EPA Registration Number	Status identifying the product as a pesticide/device under FIFRA	Enter the valid EPA Registration Number matching that product
Pesticide device	EPA Establishment Number	Status identifying the product as a pesticide/device under FIFRA	Enter the final producing establishment's EPA Establishment Number shown on the label
Valid FIFRA registration exemption	EPA Registration Number	Status for a product qualifying for a FIFRA registration exemption	Leave blank
Genuinely neither pesticide nor device	EPA Registration Number	This product is not a pesticide or pesticide device	Leave blank

01	APPLY	Use the correct value for every affected child ASIN or SKU; inspect the parent separately.
02	LOCKED / MISSING	Preserve the screenshot or feed error; do not enter 0, invent a number or use a similar field.
03	LINK CASES	Open the catalog case and reference it in the policy appeal; retain batch ID and processing report.
04	VERIFY	Check the resulting value, restriction, offer and stranded inventory after processing.

FIELD BOUNDARY: These are Amazon catalog choices, not a complete statement of FIFRA compliance. [S13,S14]



Before you submit the evidence packet

A checked item is present, product-specific and reconciled - not merely mentioned.

A / NOTICE + INVENTORY

- ☐ Full notice, policy reason, ASIN/SKU, marketplace, variation, case ID and deadline preserved.
- ☐ Live page, seller contribution and timestamped screenshots saved before correction.
- ☐ FBA quantity and every stranded, removal or disposal deadline tracked separately.

B / PRODUCT + CLAIM

- ☐ BOM, ingredients, treatments, bundled inputs and physical mechanism documented.
- ☐ Factory, final packager or relabeler, importer and producing establishment identified.
- ☐ Front end, backend, A+, product, package, instructions, other marketing and history audited.

C / ROUTE EVIDENCE

- ☐ Exactly one route is stated and every material uncertainty or contrary fact is recorded.
- ☐ Registration, establishment or exemption status is supported and never described as EPA approval.
- ☐ Claims are supported, or an erroneous value is corrected everywhere with a before-and-after record.

D / AMAZON SUBMISSION

- ☐ Pesticide Marking status, dropdown and number or blank follow the current instruction.
- ☐ One packet links photos, technical records, catalog and change records, regulatory proof and notice.
- ☐ The remedy is precise; case and batch IDs are linked; catalog, restriction, offer and inventory outcomes are verified.

READY ONLY IF

The product, mechanism, claim universe, regulatory status, Amazon field value and requested remedy all support the same route. If an essential link is missing, record and resolve the gap before resubmission.

CHECKLIST OUTPUT: one classification statement, one reconciled exhibit index, one precise request. [S01-S14]
